PURPOSES FOR REQUESTING YOUR PERSONAL DATA:

The personal data we collect will be used for the following purposes, which are necessary for the service you are requesting:

- To provide you with information about our services.
- To share information about promotions, updates, and events related to our services.
- For marketing purposes, including IT, research, operations, administration, and commercial activities.
- To carry out the admissions process, which requires personal data from applicants.
- To complete enrollment and re-enrollment processes for members of the school community.

Important: According to the second paragraph of Article 21 of the LGPDPPSO, consent for the use of your personal data for the purposes listed above will be considered granted if, after being informed through this Privacy Notice, you do not express otherwise.

In this case, by completing your registration in the system, you authorize the use and processing of your personal data.

REFUSAL TO CONSENT TO THE USE OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

TRANSFER OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

We inform you that your personal data will not be transferred to third parties, except when required by a competent authority through a formally justified request.
