The **PAD** is the result of the work of our experts in learning, pedagogy and technology. This program is custom made to the needs that are specific to the age of the students and its objective is that the learning continues to be meaningful, challenging and amazing regardless of the distance. This is achieved through synchronous and asynchronous classes, activities that the students follow to reinforce the contents of the classes and the delivery of evidence of learning that our teachers use to give feedback to the students.



Synchronous classes: Live classes that are taught using Google Meet. The students must attend these sessions following the dress code established in the Student Code of Conduct. The use of the School's uniform is suggested during synchronous classes.



Asynchronous classes: Recordings of the live classes and tutorials made by the teachers explicitly to be used outside the synchronous classes.
